



### **Where is Hunter Lodging located?**

Hunter Lodging is conveniently located on Hunter Army Airfield minutes from the Montgomery Gate in the heart of Coastal Savannah Georgia. Many historical sites and scenic tourist spots are only minutes away. Maps and tourist information is available at the front desk. Hunter Lodging is the 2005 Army Lodging, Lodging of the Year winner in the small category.

### **How are rooms reserved?**

Rooms can be reserved by calling 912-315-4121/351-5910 or by visiting Hunter Lodging, building 6010. Authority to occupy and priority of assignment for guest room reservations will follow current Army Regulations. Official duty travel, PCS & TDY have priority. Military leisure travelers can make reservations on a space available basis two weeks in advance. A valid credit card will be required to guarantee reservations.

### **How far in advance can I make a reservation?**

If you are on official orders, you can call one year in advance. If it is unofficial travel, reservations can be made 14 days in advance.

### **What happens if I make a reservation and I don't arrive on the date of reservation?**

If you cannot arrive on the day of the reservation and you do not call prior to 2:00 pm the day of the reservation to cancel, you will be charged a no-show fee for one nights lodging and your reservation is cancelled. If you call prior to 2:00 pm the day of the reservation and inform lodging of the delay, you will not be charged, and lodging will attempt, subject to availability, to adjust your reservations to accommodate your new travel plans.

### **What do guests need to provide when checking in?**

Guests on unofficial travel must provide a military identification card along with source of payment for room. Guests on official travel must also provide a copy of orders.

### **What type of amenities/services does Hunter Army Lodging offer?**

Hunter Lodging offers 32 two-bedroom suites and 5 single rooms with cable TV with HBO, DVD and VCR, a kitchenette that consists of pots, pans, dishware, silverware along with a small fridge, stove and microwave. Daily housekeeping services are offered, daily coffee service and a complimentary guest laundry is conveniently located within the facility next to the front office.

### **Are pet rooms available?**

Pet rooms are available and reservations must be made well in advance due to limited space.

The Hunter Lodging facility is an Army sponsored lodging facility that is operated by Hunter Army Airfield's Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR). Landmark Inn is a commercial lodging facility that operates on Hunter Army Airfields under a Private, Public, and Venture (PPV) contract with Army's Community Family Support Center (CFSC) who oversees Army Lodging Facilities worldwide. Landmark Inn's PPV contract authorizes them to operate on Hunter Army Airfield. While Hunter Lodging and Landmark Inn staffs do not have a formal agreement, they work side-by-side harmoniously to provide Army travelers with exceptional customer service and facilities.
