New Student Registration Information

Board of Education Departments The following documents are required by the Bryan County Board of Education to complete enrollment for Bids/RFP's a student:

- **Immunization record:** An adequate and up-to-date immunization record (Form 3231) must be on file. Out-of-state immunization records must be transferred to Georgia Form 3231. Immunizations and forms may be obtained from the
 - Bryan County Health Department, another Georgia Health Department, or from a private physician.
 - Parents enrolling military children in Bryan County Schools should contact medical personnel at the military base for Georgia health forms.
- **Eye-Ear-Dental Exam:** Georgia Form 3300 must be on file stating that the student has received a screening examination for eye, ear, and dental. The exams and forms may be obtained at the Bryan County Health Department, another Georgia Health Department, or from a private physician. Parents enrolling military children in Bryan County Schools should contact medical personnel at the military base for Georgia health forms.
- **Proof of Residency:** Written proof must be supplied that the parent or legal guardian and student reside fulltime in Bryan County. Acceptable items for documentation are:
 - House purchase contract (proof residence is occupied), mortgage statement, signed lease, signed rental/lease agreement, signed closing statement, or signed rental receipts. Documentation must have a street address listed; post office box addresses are not acceptable proof of residence.
- **Social Security Card:** The student's social security card must be provided at the time of enrollment.
- **Birth Certificate:** A copy of the student's birth certificate must be on file at the time of enrollment.
- **Proof of Grade Level:** A student transferring from another school system must furnish a withdrawal form and must also have a report card or other verification of grade placement. High school students must have a transcript. If such a form cannot be presented, the school must be furnished with the phone number and name of the previous school so grade level and withdrawal status can be verified.
- **Proof of Physical Address:** When a cell phone is listed as the home phone number, a bill indicating the appropriate physical address must be provided in addition to other residency information.

New Important Immunization Information

NEW IMMUNIZATION RULES FOR CHILDREN ENROLLED IN CHILD CARE FACILITIES (INCLUDES HEAD START AND PREKINDERGARTEN)

**EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007, ALL CHILDREN ATTENDING CHILD CARE FACILITIES ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THE FOLLOWING NEW VACCINE REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) If your child is under five (5) years of age, he must have protection against pneumococcal disease. He will need the Pneumococcal Conjugate vaccine (PCV). The number of doses needed will depend on the child's age.
- 2) If your child was born on or after January 1, 2006 and attends child care facilities (including Pre-K), he must

have two (2) doses of Hepatitis A (Hep A)vaccine or laboratory proof of immunity.

3) Contact your child care facility about your child's Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231) and the expiration date. When the certificate expires, he will be required to meet the new immunization requirements.

4) If your child is currently enrolled in a 4-year-old pre-K program and has a certificate marked as "Complete for School," he may need to obtain the 2nd doses of varicella and mumps vaccines and will need to submit documentation of meeting the new requirements on the Georgia Certificate of Immunization upon entry to school (5-year-old kindergarten).

5) Contact your health care professional to receive any needed vaccinations and to obtain a new Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231). Photocopies are accepted.

Immunization Rules for 6th Grade Students

****ALL CHILDREN ENTERING 6TH GRADE (ON OR AFTER July 1, 2007) ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THE FOLLOWING NEW REQUIREMENTS:**

1) Have two (2) doses of Measles vaccine, two (2) doses of Mumps vaccine, and one (1) dose of Rubella vaccine or laboratory proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps or Rubella.

2) Have two (2) doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or documentation of disease or laboratory proof of immunity. At the time your child entered school only one (1) dose of this vaccine was required.

3) Contact your health care provider to receive any needed vaccinations and to obtain the Georgia Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231).

Special Note to Military Families

Free and Reduced Meal Price Policy for Deployed Service Members

For the purpose of determining household size, deployed service members should be considered family members living apart on a temporary basis and should be considered a household member. However, only that portion of the deployed service member's income made available by them or on their behalf to the household will be counted as income to the household. Graduation Requirements for Students Enrolling in the 9th grade in 2008-2009


The chart below represents the graduation requirements for 9th graders enrolling at the high school in 2008-2009. ALL students will be required to complete the requirements listed above. Your selection of courses will be extremely important.

In addition, guidance from adults (parents, counselor, advisor, instructors) can assist you in making these very important decisions. Remember you should have done some investigation about career possibilities prior to selecting your classes at the high school. High school will begin to prepare you for the next step you take and that will depend on the answer to the question, "Where Am I Going?"

Gathering information and keeping that information in an organized, systematic format will help you and your parents/guardian make more informed decisions about your future. Selecting high school courses is one of the most important things you will do because your future depends on it. Good Luck!!!

Remember there are other requirements for graduation such as passing the [Georgia High School Graduation Test](#) or your local system may require additional units/credits for graduation.
