The Special Needs Accommodation Process establishes guidelines and procedures to meet every child's special needs by determining the safest, least-restrictive and most appropriate placement of a child, youth or teen. The purpose of SNAP is to ensure that each individual's environment and involvement in a CYS Services program will promote positive interaction with peers and stimulate physical involvement in activities within their ability. As a parent, your participation is a key element to your child's growth and development. The SNAP Team meets every Wednesday of each week at 0900 and services by appointments only. **FAMILY CHILD CARE (FCC)** offers both quarters-based care provided by authorized military family members from housing located on the Installation and Family Child Care in Homes off-Post (FCCHOP) provided by family members and civilians who have been Georgia State and FCC certified. FCC provides a smaller family environment for full day, part day, hourly, extended and long term care. FCC can also address special needs children and newborn infants. ## MST After School Club is FREE!

MST Bryan Village youth Center has a gymnasium for basketball, volleyball, and other active sports and games, a computer lab with 15 state-of-the-art computers, a homework room, arts & craft room, game room, teen room, dance room, and a multipurpose room. A homework tutor is on board to assist youth and teens needing help with homework. The Technology facilitator is skilled in computer repair, game console repair, robotics, movie making, and more. Organized activities such as club meetings, cooking, sports, and games are facilitated by trained CYPAs and led by youth leaders. Operating hours during the school year:

- Mon-Thu: 1400-2000
- Fri: 1400-2200
- Sat: 1200-2000
- Sun: 1400-1800
- CLOSED during Federal Holidays

## School-Age Occasional User

Designed as a short term child care option for youth in grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>, the Occasional User Program has been implemented to meet the needs of those families who require care for less than 10 hours a week before and/or after school. Transportation is provided to and from our SAS site and designated on-post schools. Patrons who utilize less than 4 hours of care during one operational day will pay a **\$16** fee. Patrons who exceed 4 hours of care in one operational day will pay a **\$30** fee. Care is provided at 507 Davis Ave, Bldg. 6571. Call 767-5662 or 767-2635! Reservations are required to accommodate DODEA school transportation policies and in accordance with AR 608-10.
